About the programmes

Programme durations runs 9- 13 sessions, at 2-3 hours per session. An additional session may be conducted at your request and may include your spouse, family, church leader, priest, family leaders or friends to be present at the meeting. The session may be used in anyway you see fit, for example healing, forgiveness, or reconciliation.
